Woodland Library Rose Club Scholarship

The Woodland Library Rose Club founded in 1989, maintains three significant rose gardens located on the Woodland Library grounds.

Scholarship Information

- 1. This scholarship is for one year.
- 2. All scholarship money will be mailed to the Registrars of the respective college, university or trade school to be dispersed to the student one-half of the scholarship per semester.
- 3. The Woodland Library Rose Club Board of Directors will determine the number of scholarships and amount of the scholarships to be awarded each year based on the funds available.
- 4. Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded in 2013. \$500 will be awarded at the beginning of the first semester and the remaining \$500 will be awarded at the beginning of the second semester.
- 5. Written applications must be submitted by June 30, 2013 (postmarked).
- 6. Selections will be made by the Woodland Library Rose Club Scholarship Committee. All applicants will be notified by letter of their outcome.
- 7. Results will be announced in July.
- 8. If the recipient drops out of school, the balance of the money will be returned to the Woodland Library Rose Club.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be related to a Woodland Library Rose Club member.
- Applicant must reside in Yolo County.
- 3. Applicant must be a graduating senior of a California High School with a current 3.0 grade point average or an enrolled Trade School, Junior College, College, or University student with a current 2.75 grade point average. Transcript of grade records must accompany High School Senior application. College applicants may send a copy of their grade report.
- 4. Applicant must be accepted at a Trade School, Junior College, College, or University. Copy of acceptance must accompany application.
- 5. Selection of scholarship recipients will be based on: academic record; participation in extra-curricular activities; moral character; and relationship to a current member of the Woodland Library Rose Club.
