


Water Conservation Data for September 2009







During September, the City of Woodland used 537,926,564 gallons of water, or 9,538 gallons per person. This amount was the lowest water use for the month of September in the last 10 years. The estimated monthly savings for September from city rebates and city leak repairs totaled 42,204 gallons. In addition, city staff responded to 25 water waste reports and fixed 38 leaks.

Environmental Services reminds residents, businesses, and City Departments to cut back on winter landscape watering and to reset your irrigation controllers for the cooler, wetter weather.
