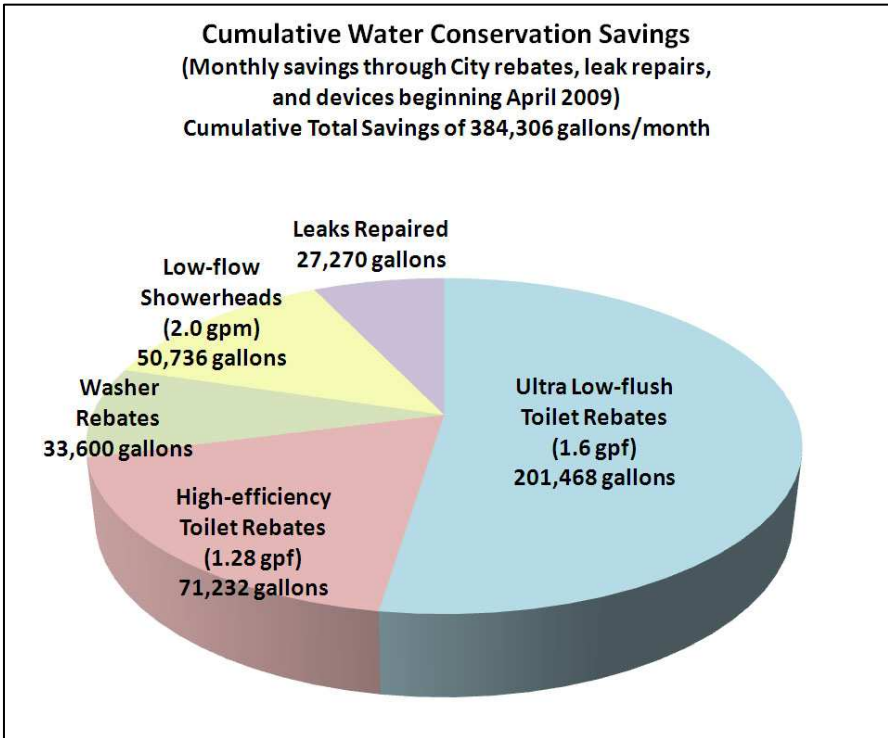
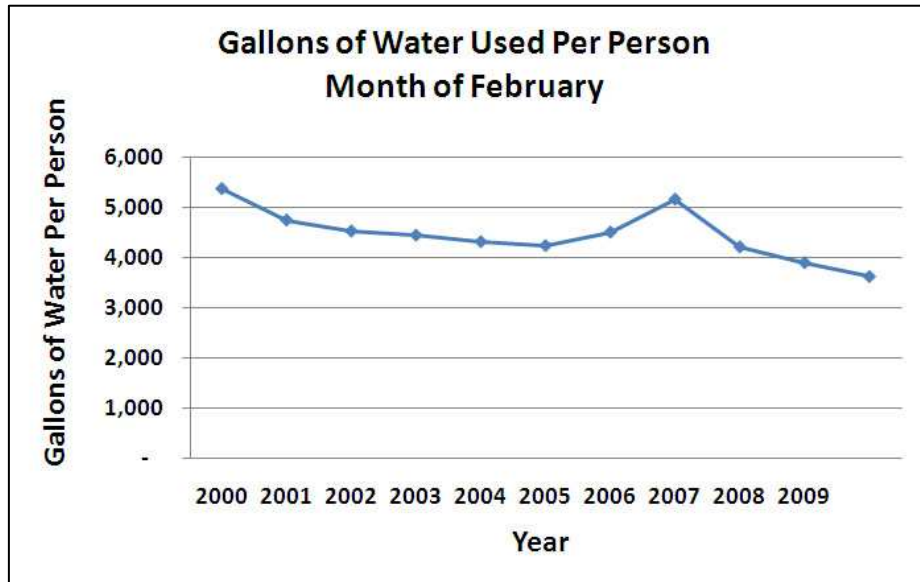
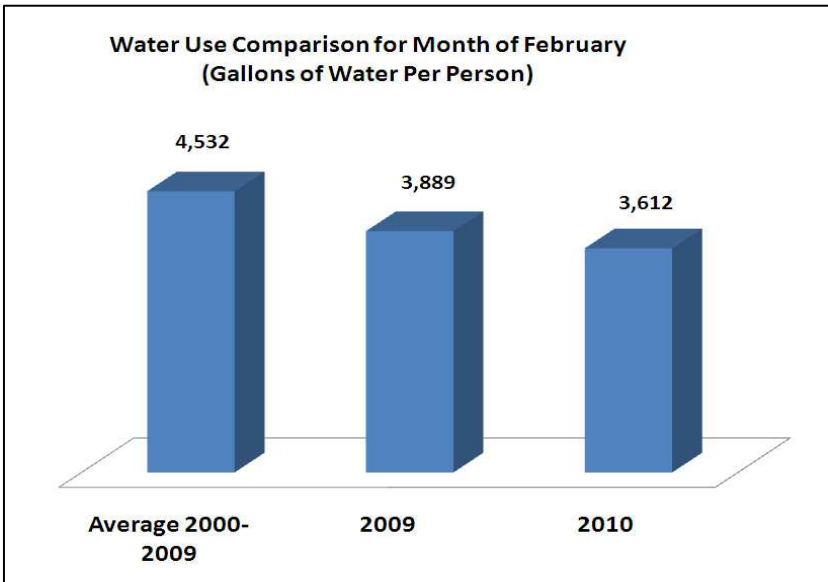


Water Conservation Data for February 2010



During February, the City of Woodland used 203,732,944 gallons of water, or 3,612 gallons per person. This amount was the lowest water use for the month of February in the last 11 years. The estimated monthly savings for February from city rebates and city leak repairs totaled 1,890 gallons. In addition, city staff responded to 3 water waste reports and fixed 21 leaks.

Environmental Services reminds residents, businesses, and City Departments to cut back on winter landscape watering and to reset your irrigation controllers for the cooler, wetter weather.
