The Woodland City Council met in adjourned session at 7:30 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers for a joint meeting with the Woodland Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Karen Prado, resident of Woodland, made comments during the public comment portion of the meeting addressing High School residential neighborhood concerns.

HIGH SCHOOL PARKING AND TRAFFIC CONCERNS:

Dr. Robert Watt, Superintendent of Schools, made a presentation on Woodland High School parking problems and issues. He said students have the same rights for public parking as residents. Dr. Watt suggested term parking as a possible solution. It was suggested that a committee be formed to address safety hazards. Closing the campus was discussed as an option.

PLANS FOR SECOND HIGH SCHOOL:

Dr. Watt reported that with growth of the City and new development consideration needs to be given to a second high school site or expanding Woodland High School.

He advised that the School Board has selected a combined middle and high school

site and an EIR has been completed for the proposal.

SOUTHEAST AREA DEVELOPMENT PLANS:

City Manager Kris Kristensen reported that the Southeast Area specific plan has been approved. The next task is to develop a financing plan to provide public facilities. Construction is planned for the beginning of next year.

Dr. Watt reported that plans will be developed to determine if land values will support needed public facilities.

The City Manager explained the specific plan requires that the development of the Southeast Area meet the public needs of the community including school sites.
