Decisions need to be made as to how the downtown area should develop/evolve in the future.

Commercial businesses should first be encouraged to in fill currently designated commercial zones rather than creating expanded commercial zones.

Woodland's Chamber of Commerce should be asked to conduct direct business recruitment, not City staff.

Further clarification of economic development focus was difficult to do. This topic will be discussed further in the regular meetings with the Chamber of Commerce.
