- Compliance Requirements:**
- 65% of the C&D materials from this project must be recycled and/or reused
 - 100% of excavated soil and land clearing debris must be diverted from landfills
 - Universal waste items (fluorescent lamps, thermometers, electronic devices, batteries, etc.) shall be disposed of properly and shall be listed in the construction documents
 - WRR Report and proof of diversion must be submitted to the City at the end of the project
